## Feedback from the CMS Parent Questionnaire.

An overwhelming majority of parents/carers told us that their children feel safe at school, pupils are well behaved and that they would recommend the school to others. In addition, parents/carers also said there was a good range of subjects and clubs available at CMS and that their children develop well over their time here. Parent/Carer Feedback	CMS response
You would like improved communication from CMS.	We have introduced a ½ termly newsletter that contains a mini calendar for key events coming up in the following ½ term. Our website and Facebook page will still be active. Epraise will continue to be used for most communication.
You would like to see a broader range of educational visits reintroduced.	We are currently working towards having 3 curriculum trips each year in addition to our reward events. We are working with Catshill First School to ensure there is good curriculum coverage across both schools. We are aware of cost implications and are working hard to secure value for money solutions.
You would like more opportunities for parental involvement.	The first step we have taken is forming a PTA group that will be organising fundraising events for your children. We welcome more parent involvement in your child's education and are in the process of organising subject workshops to enable this.
You wanted more information about how well your child was doing at CMS.	From February 2024, every term we will be sending out a STAR report (maths and English). This is in addition to consultation evenings and end of year reports. We are currently working towards applying this to other subjects.
You asked for more information for parents/carers of new starters.	A new booklet of information will be provided to Y4 parents/carers in July

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	2024. This is alongside transition sessions and a welcome evening in July. Updates will regularly be added to our website.
You asked for the fabric of the school to receive building improvements.	A rolling programme of refurbishment has already started and more will be done before the end of this academic year. We are pleased to share that we have recently decorated the reception area and have plans to replace the flooring and decorate in areas of the school.
