Challenge learners, enabling them to make good progress and successfully achieve their full potential

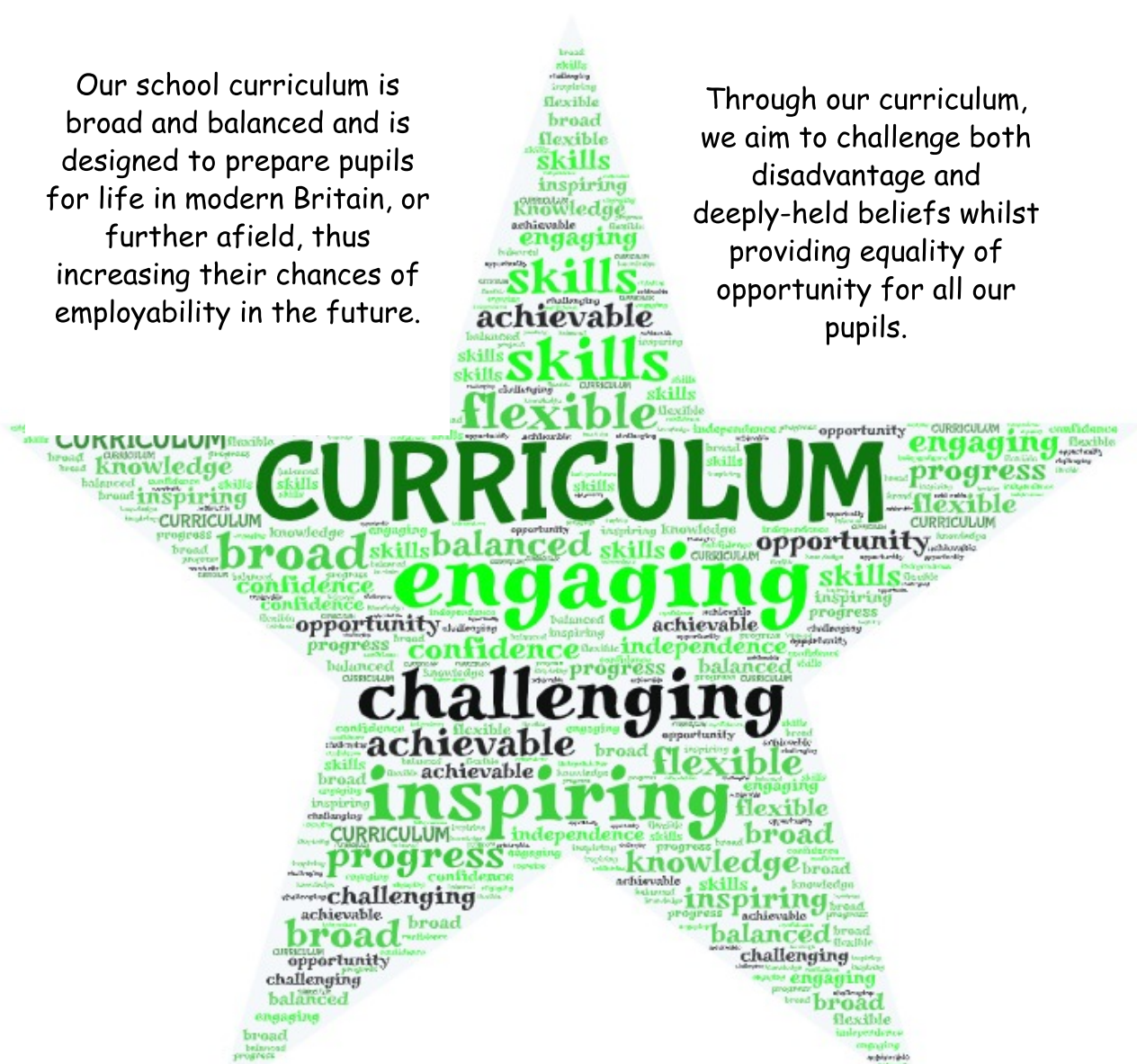
Provide opportunities that result in employable young people who have a range of transferable skills that will be useful in a future job market
